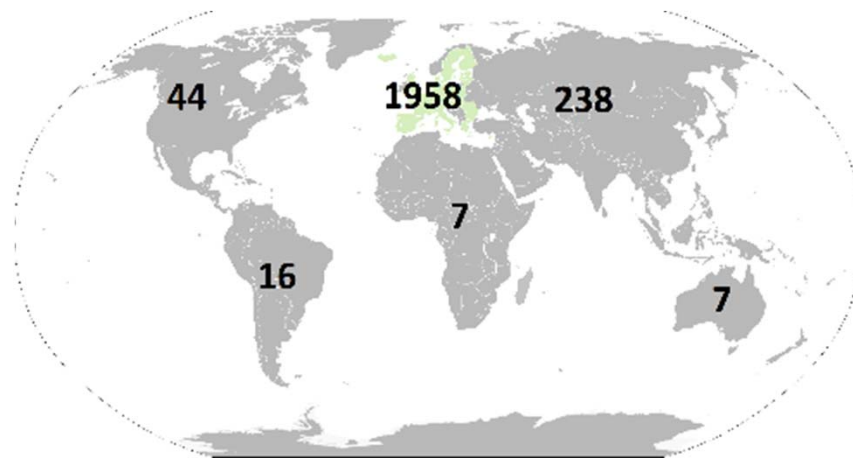


Study at the University of Ljubljana

Instructions for incoming students

- You should regularly attend the classes according to the published timetables and in agreement with the teachers.
- If you wish to change your Learning Agreement, discuss the changes with adequate teachers and bring the form Changes to Original Learning Agreement to International Office.
- **Learning Agreements shall be changed not later than in the first 3 weeks of the semester.**

ID numbers, Digital Identity

All foreign students receive Personal ID number issued by the Ministry of Internal Affairs. It is required to apply for monthly bus ticket, food coupons, etc.
