Instructions for incoming students

- You are invited to come to our International Office, room P-3 (ground floor), Jamova 2 (<u>romana.hudin@fgg.uni-lj.si</u>), where you will receive welcome materials and the required documents. You may also bring documents to be signed.
- PLEASE COME INDIVIDUALLY, not in groups.
- For individual review of learning agreements and information about responsible teachers of individual courses you can come to the International Office, search our internet pages or consult the student tutors.
- Classes start today, on October 1, 2020. For the classes scheduled on the Timetable, please go to the next scheduled lectures or tutorials.
- For the courses delivered in the form of individual consultations, you should contact the teachers **within the first week** of the semester. Please contact them first by e-mail! They will define your obligations, study literature, seminar work, etc.

Instructions for incoming students

- You should regularly attend the classes according to the published timetables and in agreement with the teachers.
- If you wish to change your Learning Agreement, discuss the changes with adequate teachers and bring the form Changes to Original Learning Agreement to the International Office.
- Learning Agreements shall be changed not later than in the first 2 weeks of the semester.
- Registration for exams is online through Web pages for student affairs.
- You should finish all the defined obligations and exams before you leave and go back home. It is not allowed to make exams from your home institution.
- Before you leave, you can receive your final Transcript of Records in the International Office.

In the winter semester of the academic year 2020/21, UL FGG offers the following courses in English:

ID numbers, Digital Identity

All foreign students receive Personal ID number issued by the Ministry of Internal Affairs. It is required to apply for monthly bus ticket, for accomodation, food coupons, etc.
