Instructions for incoming students

- You should regularly attend the classes according to the published timetables and in agreement with the teachers.
- If you wish to change your Learning Agreement, discuss the changes with adequate teachers and bring the form Changes to Original Learning Agreement to the International Office.
- Learning Agreements shall be changed not later than in the first 2 weeks of the semester.
- Registration for exams is online through Web pages for student affairs.
- You should finish all the defined obligations and exams before you leave and go back home. It is not allowed to make exams from your home institution.
- Before you leave, you can receive your final Transcript of Records in the International Office.
