- Classes start today, on October 3, 2022. For the classes scheduled on the Timetable, please go to the next scheduled lectures or tutorials.
- For the courses delivered in the form of individual consultations, you should contact the teachers **within the first week** of the semester. Please contact them first by e-mail! They will define your obligations, study literature, seminar work, etc.

Instructions for incoming students

- You should regularly attend the classes according to the published timetables and in agreement with the teachers.
- Changes of your Learning Agreements are possible, but not recommended. Any changes must be coordinated with the International Office and the Erasmus Coordinator.
- Learning Agreements shall be changed not later than in the first 2 weeks of the semester.
- Registration for exams is online through Web pages for student affairs.
- You should finish all the defined obligations and exams **before you leave** and go back home. It is not allowed to make exams from your home institution.
- Before you leave, you can receive your final Transcript of Records in the International Office.

TIMETABLES AND COURSES

In the winter semester of the academic year 2022/23, UL FGG offers the following courses in English:

Urban Planning, 4 ECTS Structural Analysis, 5 ECTS Hydraulic Structures, 8 ECTS Building Information Modelling, 6 ECTS Transportation Engineering, 4 ECTS Drinking Water Supply and Treatment, 8 ECTS Environmental Technologies, 4 ECTS Introduction to Drainage Engineering, 4 ECTS Spatial Planning for Flood Protection, 5 ECTS Hydroelectric Power, 4 ECTS

Combined implementation: **Geotechnics + Fundamentals of Soil Mechanics**, 6 + 5 ECTS **Fundamentals of Earthquake Engineering + Structural Dynamics and Earthquake Engineering**, 4 + 7 ECTS **Steel Structures**, 6 ECTS (contents from first and second cycle)

If you selected these courses, you cannot cancel them! This is necessary to keep the group sizes.
