- Classes in the winter semester start today, October 2, 2023. Your classes start tomorrow, October 3. For the classes scheduled on the Timetable, please go to the next scheduled lectures or tutorials.
- For the courses delivered in the form of individual consultations, you should contact the teachers within the first week of the semester. Please contact them first by e-mail! They will define your obligations, study literature, seminar work, etc.

## Instructions for incoming students

- You should regularly attend the classes according to the published timetables and in agreement with the teachers.
- Changes of your Learning Agreements are possible, but not recommended. Any changes must be coordinated with the International Office and the Erasmus Coordinator.
- Learning Agreements shall be changed not later than in the first 2 weeks of the semester.
- Registration for exams is online through Web pages for student affairs.
- You should finish all the defined obligations and exams before you leave and go back home. It is not allowed to make exams from your home institution.
- When you have finished all the exams, inform the International Office and we will provide your final Transcript of Records.

## **TIMETABLES AND COURSES**

In the winter semester of the academic year 2023/24, UL FGG offers the following courses in English:

**Urban Planning**, 4 ECTS Cartography, 8 ECTS Satellite Aided Geodetic Survey, 6 ECTS **Computer Programming**, 4 ECTS Photogrammetry I, 5 ECTS **Geoinformatics I, 6 ECTS Fundamentals of Soil Mechanics 5 ECTS Geotechnics**, 6 ECTS Fundamentals of Earthquake Engineering, 4 ECTS Steel Structures, 6 ECTS **Surface Drainage (urban drainage)**, 4 ECTS Selected Chapters from Concrete and Masonry Structures, 6 ECTS Structural Analysis, 5 ECTS **Hydraulic Structures**, 8 ECTS Fire Resistance of Structures. 5 ECTS Transportation Engineering, 4 ECTS Repair and Testing of Structures, 5 ECTS Spatial Planning for Flood Protection, 5 ECTS **Hydroelectric Power**,4 ECTS

If you selected these courses, you cannot cancel them! This is necessary to keep the group sizes. You may join any of these classes.

## **TIMETABLES AND COURSES**

The course **Socio-Economical Assessment of Flood Protection** will be provided as an intensive course in early December. You will be informed about the details.

The courses **Spatial Planning for Flood Protection** and **Repair and Testing of Structures** start **next week** according to the timetable.

The course **Geotechnics** requires prior knowledge from soil mechanics. If you don't have this knowledge, we advise you to join the course **Fundamentals of Soil Mechanics** for the first 6 weeks and then follow the lectures in **Geotechnics** for the remaining 9 weeks.

All other courses not on the timetable will be available mostly in the form of individual consultations or participation at tutorials.

## Student cards, ID numbers, Digital Identity
