## Instructions for incoming students

- For signatures to required documents please send or bring them to the International Office. They must be completed and ready for signatures. The International Office will send the signed documents back to you by e-mail.

- Classes in the winter semester start today, October 1, 2025. Your classes start tomorrow, October 2. For the classes scheduled on the <u>Timetable</u>, please go to the next scheduled lectures or tutorials.
- For the courses delivered in the form of individual consultations, you should contact the teachers within the first week of the semester. Please contact them first by e-mail! They will define your obligations, study literature, seminar work, etc.

## Instructions for incoming students

- You should regularly attend the classes according to the published timetables and in agreement with the teachers.
- Changes of your Learning Agreements are possible, but not recommended. Any changes must be coordinated with the International Office and the Erasmus Coordinator.
- Learning Agreements shall be changed not later than in the first 2 weeks of the semester.
- Registration for exams is online through Web pages for student affairs.
- You should finish all the defined obligations and exams before you leave and go back home. It is not allowed to do exams from your home institution.
- When you have finished all the exams, you can download your final Transcript of Records from the Web pages for student affairs.

## Student cards, ID numbers, Digital Identity

As students of the University of Ljubljana, you will receive your student cards. Unfortunately, they are late this year. You will be informed when they arrive.

All foreign students receive Personal ID number issued by the Ministry of Internal Affairs. It is required to apply for monthly bus ticket, for accommodation, food coupons, etc.
